Unter Coats & Car Seats

How to stay warm AND safe

Bulky winter coats and snow pants should not be worn in a car seat as it makes the harness straps too loose to be effective in a crash.



No coat or a light weight fleece.
Wear a warmer coat while going to and from the car.



The fluff of a bulky winter coat can compress in a car crash making harness straps loose, which can cause injury or ejection.



No coat. Use a blanket for warmth.

Remember to "Strap Before You Wrap"



Harness child, then put coat on backwards.



Unzip coat, then buckle child.

Warm your car ahead of time when possible.
