




Safe Kids know how to call for help in an emergency.

Safe Kids wear a helmet when doing wheeled sports.








Safe Kids use a crosswalk to get across the street.






Safe Kids stay away from farm machinery.



Safe Kids stay away from items that can be poisonous.




Color the items that are safe to eat.

Cross out the ones that are dangerous.




Safe Kids always swim with a buddy and watchful adult.


