


SUMMER VEHICLE SAFETY



Heatstroke can happen to good parents!

Even in the shade, the temperature in the car can still rise quickly to **dangerous levels.**

SAFETY TIPS

- NEVER** leave children unattended in a vehicle. NOT EVEN FOR A MINUTE!
- ALWAYS** check the backseat. Put your wallet, shoe or purse in the back as a reminder.
- ALWAYS** keep vehicles locked and keys out of reach.
- MAKE** arrangements with your childcare provider to call if your child is absent.
- CALL 911** if you see a child alone in a vehicle.

70°	89°	104°
75°	94°	109°
80°	99°	114°
85°	104°	119°
90°	109°	124°
95°	114°	129°

How do children die of heatstroke in a car?

- 53%** Forgotten (nearly half not dropped off at childcare)
- 26%** Gained access on their own
- 20%** Left intentionally
- 1%** Unknown
